


PROJECT PURPOSE

- Improve Safety
- Improve Traffic Flow
- Reduce Roadway Flooding
- Replace Deficient Bridges (80 years old)
- Meet Roadway Classification

PROJECT LOCATION





EXISTING PROJECT AREA CONDITIONS



Brea Canyon Road

- Road limits: approx. 1.4 mile segment
- 30 feet wide
 2 lanes
 Undivided highway

Brea Canyon Channel

- Flood limits: approx. 1,100-foot segment
- **30 feet wide** (bottom width)

• **Riprap** (lined with rock)

• Side Slopes 1:1.5 (H:V)


EXISTING ROAD CONDITIONS



- 3 bridge crossings within the road limits
- 3 intersections within the road limits
 - Tonner Canyon Road
 - Canyon County Road
 - Canyondale Drive
- Multiple driveway access points
- Posted speed limit
 - 55 mph in unincorporated portion
 - 45 mph in City of Brea
- Sight-lines do not meet current design standards
- High congestion during AM & PM peak hours

PROPOSED ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS Of CPublicWorks



Road widening

- 11-foot min. lane width
- 6-foot to 10-foot shoulder width

Road median

- 12-foot to 14-foot raised median OR;
- 6-foot wide w/concrete barrier
- Multiple retaining walls
- Horizontal & vertical realignment

PROPOSED ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS



- New signal at Tonner Canyon Road
- Signalized driveway
- Signal modification at Canyon Country Road
- Replace 3 bridges
- Modify culverts
- Relocate utilities
- Improve/modify existing driveway access


